CHAPTER ANNOUNCEMENTS and WANT ADS:

- **Get ready for a new and fun activity this year at our Holiday Auction! Prepare yourself to have a jolly time at our **wine pull, magnum raffle, and Topsy Elf raffle!!!****
- **The **wine pull** will consist of 20+ bottles of wine valued from \$10 to \$25 dollars. Chapters members will simply pay \$10 to one of the elves at the table, and pull the bottle of wine that they choose! (No tickets involved!) The color of the tissue paper indicates what is inside: Red for a red wine, white for a white wine, and green for a bottle that falls "in between". To add to the excitement, two of the bottles will also have certificates for a wine tasting taped to them! Cooper's Hawk Winery and Lynfred Winery both contributed wine tastings!**
- **The magnum raffle will involve purchasing a special \$5 ticket. (PLEASE write your paddle number on the back of your ticket before depositing it in the designated raffle bag.) The magnum is 1.5 liters of "Dodici" wine. It is a special blend prepared by Cooper's Hawk winery. It consists of 75% Barbera and 25% Sangiovese red wines. This magnum was bottled for Cooper's Hawk's 12th anniversary in 2017, and will age nicely through 2025. It's value is over \$60.00. It will make a great addition to a party or a special holiday dinner!**
- **There WILL be a Topsy Elf On the Shelf raffle!!! Tickets will cost \$1 per 1 ticket, or \$5 for 6 tickets. PLEASE NOTE: These will be different colored tickets than the magnum raffle. (Members will write their paddle number on these tickets also.) These tickets will be placed in raffle bags that are labeled in front of each raffle object. We have WONDERFUL items to raffle off!!! Each item is wine or appetizer related, and will make a nice addition to your party products, or a nice hostess gift to give at the holidays!!!**

A \$2,000 scholarship will be given for UNDERGRADUATE (attention collegiate members) or GRADUATE work for members enrolled in courses of six hours or more at an accredited college or university after the 2020 IL state convention. IL State also has available funds to award up to \$2,000 for special study stipends to support educational activities not in a degree program.
